

Rear Admiral Cari Thomas is pleased to serve as the Chief Executive Officer, Coast Guard Mutual Assistance. The organization, formed in 1924 as the League of Coast Guard Women, has a long history as a military service organization whose motto is "We Look After Our Own." With assets in excess of \$32 million, Coast Guard Mutual Assistance helped over 5200 members with interest free loans or grants and over 8500 students with educational program support in 2016. While on active duty, she was President, USCG Mutual Assistance Board of Control while serving as the Assistant Commandant of Human Resources.

Most recently, Rear Admiral Thomas was the Executive Director the Navy League of the United States. In this capacity, she was responsible for the oversight and management of the national staff, and supporting the more than 50,000 civilians and 220 councils that work to assist sea service members and their families. With a career of service to the United States in both public and private capacities, she also serves as a Subcommittee Chair, Defense Advisory on Women in the Services, and on the Board, Navy Mutual Aid Association.

Mrs. Thomas served her nation as a career Coast Guardsman, having achieved over 32 years as a commissioned officer. During her career, she earned command both afloat and ashore. Rear Admiral Thomas also has experience in marketing, financial management, personnel, constituency services and disaster management. Her flag assignments included Assistant Commandant, Response Policy (CG-5R), Assistant Commandant, Human Resources (CG-1) and Commander, Coast Guard District Fourteen based in Honolulu, Hawaii. She was named a United States International Maritime Organization (IMO) Ambassador in 2015.

Mrs. Thomas also served her community through volunteer programs such as English is a Second Language, building homes with Habitat for Humanity, gleaning crops to help feed families, and transporting shelter dogs with Homeward Trails Animal Rescue. As a Board President, Chair, service advisor or Member, Cari has assisted a number of non-profit boards including: US Coast Guard Academy Alumni Association, Sea Services Leadership Association, US Naval Institute, Red Cross of America, Hawaii Chapter, Girl Scouts of America, Hawaii Chapter, and Coast Guard Non-Pay Compensation Board.

Rear Admiral Thomas graduated with distinction from the Naval War College with a Masters of Arts in National Security and Strategic Studies. She earned a Master of Science in Educational Leadership from Troy State University and a Bachelor of Science degree in Civil Engineering from the Coast Guard Academy. In 2017, Mrs. Thomas earned a Non-Profit Executive Management Certificate from Georgetown University. She has completed U. S. Naval War College joint and combined force courses, as well as executive education through Harvard's National Preparedness Leadership Institute, at the Asia Pacific Center for Strategic Studies and the Department of Homeland Security's Pacific Executive Leadership Program.

Cari Thomas' personal awards include the Distinguished Service Medal, two Legions of Merit, the Department of State Superior Honor Award, the Sea Services Leadership Association "North Star" award, and various other personal, unit and campaign awards. She earned permanent cutterman status in 1994. She is married to Commander Gary Thomas, USCG (retired), and has an adult daughter and son-in-law. She currently resides in Arlington, Virginia.
